Admission Process – step by step

Application Process for Nominated Applicants:

- Nomination eligibility criteria:
 - a. Personality.
 - b. Academics (Good grades in Bachelors of Engg in Computer Science or Information Technology).
 - c. Good English skills: 7 IELTS Band or 96 TOEFL Score or C1 in Cambridge.
 - d. Pay app. 5800 CHF (6000 USD) for 2 years of study fees to university.
 - e. Sufficient funds of 24,000 CHF (25,000 USD) to take care of living costs (housing, food, medical insurance) and able to meet embassy requirements for visa.
 - f. High motivation levels to pursue the study program.

Step 1: Nominations from associate school students should be sent to krishna.penmetsa@hslu.ch with a resume/CV.

Step 2: The HSLU(I) will interact online with nominated student(s) and parents to learn more about the student and share necessary information.

Step 3: Students considered for the final round of interviews will be informed by university authorities and asked to submit complete checklist documents within one week.

Step 4: Submission of below checklist documents through email:

- o Photograph
- Resume / CV
- Passport copy
- Personal essay or Motivation letter: One page.
- Certificates: 10th,11th,12th and Bachelors of Engineering in Computer Science or Information Technology with English translation if not in English.
- IELTS/TOEFL Score report or Proof of English proficiency examination date confirmation letter (IELTS/TOEFL).
- Proof of finances: Bank statement with a minimum amount of USD 6500.

Step 5: Within one week of receiving the above documents, our Admissions board interviews the Student & Parents online and makes a decision the same day.

Step 6: HSLU(I) will inform the schools and the applicant of the final decision and provide a link for uploading the documents if accepted.

Step 7: After submitting the documents, the student and school authorities will receive a letter of confirmation and invoice within 5-10 working days.

Step 8: After receiving the admission letter and housing arrangement, the student must pay the first semester study fee and rent for a period of 6 months within 10 working days.
