The Technological University of Panama (UTP) ranks as the highest state institution of scientific-technological higher education in the Republic of Panama.

Created in August 1981, the UTP is a national leader in engineering; It serves as a center of reference and expertise in technology.

### **Academic offerings**

The UTP offers 150 programs at different levels: 7 Doctorates, 56 Master's Degrees, 22 Postgraduate Degrees, 1 Professorship, 28 Bachelor's Degrees in Engineering, 27 Bachelor's Degrees with intermediate Technical Degree, 1 Bachelor's Degree in Technology, and 9 Technical Degrees. It has a pedagogy staff of 1,750 professors, 1,886 administrative staff, and 125 researchers.

3. Resume.

4. Copy of personal identity card or passport.

5. Spanish language certificate.

6. Letter of motivation.

7. List of subjects to be taken. Table with titles: faculty, career, year, subject and subject code.

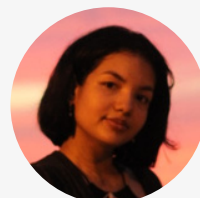
